31 Jesus took the Twelve aside and told them, "We are going up to Jerusalem, and everything that is written by the prophets about the Son of Man will be fulfilled. 32 He will be handed over to the Gentiles. They will mock him, insult him, spit on him, flog him and kill him. 33 On the third day he will rise again."

1. HIS BEING <u>BETRAYED</u> BY A <u>FRIEND</u>

Ps 41:9 Even my close friend, whom I trusted, he who shared my bread, has lifted up his heel against me.

John 13:18, 21, 26 (fulfillment)

2. HIS DISCIPLES FORSAKING HIM

Zech 13:7 ... Strike the shepherd and the sheep will be scattered...

Matt 26:31, 56 (fulfillment)

3. HIS SUFFERING BEING FOR OTHERS

<u>Isa 53:4-5</u> 4 Surely <u>he took up our infirmities</u> and <u>carried our sorrows</u>, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted. 5 But he was <u>pierced for our transgressions</u>, he was <u>crushed for our iniquities</u>; the punishment that <u>brought us peace</u> was upon him, and <u>by his wounds we are healed</u>.

4. HIS BEING SPIT ON AND FLOGGED

<u>Isa 50:6</u> <u>I offered my back to those who beat me</u>, my cheeks to those who pulled out my beard; I did not hide my face from mocking and spitting.

5. HIS BEING MOCKED

Ps 22:7-8 All who see me mock me; they hurl insults, shaking their heads: "He trusts in the Lord; let the Lord rescue him. Let him deliver him, since he delights in him."

6. HIS <u>HANDS</u> AND <u>FEET</u> BEING NAILED TO THE CROSS

Ps 22:16 Dogs have <u>surrounded me</u>; a band of <u>evil men has</u> <u>encircled me</u>, they have <u>pierced my hands and my feet</u>.

7. HIS INTERCESSION FOR HIS TRANSGRESSORS

<u>Isa 53:12</u> ... He made <u>intercession for the transgressors</u>.

8. HIS BEING FORSAKEN BY GOD

Ps 22:1 My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? Why are you so far from saving me, so far from the words of my groaning?

Matt 27:46 (fulfillment)

9. NO BONE OF HIS SHALL BE BROKEN

Ps 34:20 [The Lord] protects all his bones, not one of them will be broken.

John 19:33, 36 (fulfillment)

10. HIS BEING PIERCED

Zech 12:10 ... They will look on me, the one they have pierced...

<u>Isa 53:5</u> But <u>he was pierced for our transgressions</u>...

<u>John 19:34-35, 37</u> (fulfillment)

11. HIS <u>DEATH</u>

Isa 53:12 ... He poured out his life unto death...

12. HIS RESURRECTION

<u>Ps 16:10</u> You will <u>not abandon me to the grave</u>, nor will you <u>let your Holy One see decay</u>.
