Galatians 2:20-21

1. WE ARE A <u>BROKEN</u> PEOPLE IN NEED OF SALVATION

Rom 6:23 23 For the wages of sin is death...

<u>Gal 2:20</u> 20 <u>I have been crucified with Christ</u> and <u>I no longer live</u>, but Christ lives in me...

2. WE ARE SAVED BY <u>GRACE</u> THROUGH <u>FAITH</u>, NOT <u>WORKS</u>

<u>Gal 2:16</u>

16 ... a man is <u>not justified by observing the law</u>, <u>but by faith in</u> <u>Jesus Christ</u>...

<u>Gal 2:21</u>

21 <u>I do not set aside the grace of God</u>, for <u>if righteousness could</u> <u>be gained through the law</u>, <u>Christ died for nothing</u>!"

<u>Eph 2:8-9</u>

8 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith — and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— 9 not by works, so that no one can boast.

3. WE HAVE BEEN BOUGHT AT A <u>PRICE</u> AND NOW LIVE BY <u>FAITH</u> FOR HIM

23 For <u>the wages of sin is death</u>, but <u>the gift of God is eternal life</u> <u>in Christ Jesus our Lord</u>.
