Lessons from Galatians: Whose approval do you seek?

Galatians 1:6-12

6 I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting the one who called you by the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel— 7 which is really no gospel at all. Evidently some people are throwing you into confusion and are trying to pervert the gospel of Christ. 8 But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach a gospel other than the one we preached to you, let him be eternally condemned! 9 As we have already said, so now I say again: If anybody is preaching to you a gospel other than what you accepted, let him be eternally condemned! 10 Am I now trying to win the approval of men, or of God? Or am I trying to please men? If I were still trying to please men, I would not be a servant of Christ. 11 I want you to know, brothers, that the gospel I preached is not something that man made up. 12 I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it; rather, I received it by revelation from Jesus Christ.

I. WE ARE CALLED TO SEEK THE APPROVAL OF GOD, NOT MAN

<u>Gal 1:10</u>

10 Am I now trying to win the <u>approval of men</u>, <u>or of God</u>? Or <u>am I trying to please men</u>? <u>If I were still trying to please men</u>, I would <u>not be a servant of Christ</u>.

2. THERE IS ONLY ONE <u>TRUE</u> GOSPEL

Gal 1:6-7

6 I am astonished that you are so quickly <u>deserting the one who</u> <u>called you</u> by the grace of Christ and are <u>turning to a different</u> <u>gospel</u>— 7 which is <u>really no gospel at all</u>. Evidently some people are throwing you into confusion and are trying to <u>pervert</u> the gospel of Christ.

3. THE TRUE GOSPEL IS NOT MAN-MADE

Gal 1:11-12

II I want you to know, brothers, that the gospel I preached is not something that man made up. 12 I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it; rather, I received it by revelation from Jesus Christ.

4. PREACHING FALSE GOSPEL IS A MAJOR OFFENSE

Gal 1:8-9

8 But even <u>if we</u> or <u>an angel</u> from heaven should preach a gospel other than the one we preached to you, <u>let him be eternally condemned!</u> 9 As we have already said, so now I say again: <u>If anybody is preaching to you a gospel other than what you accepted</u>, <u>let him be eternally condemned!</u>
