Revelation 3:15-16

[To the church in Laodicea] "15 I know your deeds, that <u>you are</u> neither cold nor hot. I wish you were either one or the other! 16 So, because you are lukewarm — neither hot nor cold — I am about to spit you out of my mouth."

3 temperatures of people:

- HOT: On fire for God. Passionate about Him & His Word.
 Jesus Freak.
- <u>COLD</u>: <u>Don't</u> really <u>know</u> God. Maybe even <u>reject</u> Him. <u>Atheist</u>, <u>Agnostic</u>.
- <u>LUKEWARM</u>: Christian in <u>name only</u>. Having a <u>form of</u> godliness but <u>lacking passion and power</u>.

2 Timothy 3:1-5

1 But mark this: There will be terrible times in the last days. 2 People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, 3 without love, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not lovers of the good, 4 treacherous, rash, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God— 5 having a form of godliness but denying its power. Have nothing to do with them.
