I. <u>PROCLAIMED</u> THE GOOD NEWS OF JESUS CHRIST

Luke 2:10-12

10 But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. 11 Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord. 12 This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger."

1 John 4:10

This is love: not that we loved God, but that <u>he loved us</u> and <u>sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins</u>.

2. PRAISED HIS HOLY NAME

Luke 2:13-14

13 Suddenly <u>a great company of the heavenly host appeared</u> with the angel, <u>praising God</u> and saying, 14 "<u>Glory to God in the</u> highest, and on earth peace to men on whom his favor rests."

Isa 6:1-3

Luke 2:20

The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things they had heard and seen, which were just as they had been told.
