Got Hope? Hope for Guilt & Shame

Romans 7:15, 18-19, 22-8:3

15 <u>I</u> do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do. 16-17... 18 I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For <u>I have the desire to do what is good</u>, but <u>I cannot carry it out</u>. 19 For what I do is not the good I want to do; no, the evil I do not want to do — this I keep on doing. 20-21... 22 For in my inner being I delight in God's law; 23 but I see another law at work in the members of my body, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within my members. 24 What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body of death? 25 Thanks be to God — through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself in my mind am a slave to God's law, but in the sinful nature a slave to the law of sin. 8:1 Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, 2 because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death.

I. RECOGNIZE THE SOURCE OF GUILT & SHAME

John 10:10

"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full."

2 Corinthians 7:10

10 Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death.

Romans 8:1-2

I Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, 2 because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death.

We can overcome guilt & shame if we...

2. REALIZE BY GOD'S <u>GRACE</u> WE ARE NOT CONDEMNED

Romans 4:25-5:2

25 He was <u>delivered over to death for our sins</u> and was <u>raised</u> to life for our justification. 5:1 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, <u>we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ</u>, 2 through whom <u>we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand</u>. And we <u>rejoice in the hope</u> of the glory of God.

Galatians 2:20-21

20 <u>I have been crucified with Christ</u> and <u>I no longer live</u>, but <u>Christ lives in me</u>. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who <u>loved me</u> and <u>gave himself for me</u>. 21 <u>I do not set aside the grace of God</u>, for <u>if righteousness could be gained through the law, Christ died for nothing!</u>

Isaiah 53:10

10 Yet it was the Lord's will to crush him and cause him to suffer, and ... the Lord makes his life a guilt offering...

3. REJOICE THAT WE ARE MADE <u>RIGHTEOUS</u> THROUGH CHRIST'S SACRIFICIAL BLOOD

Galatians 3:27

all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.
