Genesis 22:7-8 (approximately 2000 BC)

7... "The fire and wood are here," Isaac said, "but <u>where is the lamb</u> for the burnt offering?" 8 Abraham answered, "<u>God himself will</u> provide the lamb for the burnt offering, my son." ...

<u>Exodus 12:13</u> (approximately 1400 BC) 13 <u>The blood will be a sign for you</u> on the houses where you are; and when I see the blood, I will pass over you...

Isaiah 53:7 (approximately 700 BC)

7 He was oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; <u>he</u> was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is silent, so he did not open his mouth.

1. OUR <u>SIN</u> HAS BEEN <u>EXPOSED</u>

Isaiah 53:6

6 <u>We all</u>, like sheep, <u>have gone astray</u>, <u>each of us has turned to</u> <u>his own way</u>;

and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

Romans 3:10

10 As it is written: "<u>There is no one righteous</u>, <u>not even one</u>"

Romans 3:23

23 for <u>all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God</u>.

2. OUR SIN HAS BEEN <u>PAID</u> IN <u>FULL</u>

<u>Isaiah 53:5</u>

5... <u>he was pierced for our transgressions</u>, <u>he was crushed for our iniquities</u>; <u>the punishment that brought us peace was upon him</u>, and <u>by his wounds we are healed</u>.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:21</u> 21 <u>God made him who had no sin</u> to be <u>sin for us</u>, so that <u>in him</u> we might <u>become the righteousness of God</u>.

<u>1 Peter 1:18-19</u>

18... <u>you were redeemed</u>... 19... <u>with the precious blood of Christ</u>, a lamb without blemish or defect.

Galatians 2:21

21 I do not set aside the grace of God, for <u>if righteousness could</u> <u>be gained through the law, Christ died for nothing</u>!"

<u>Mark 10:32</u>

32 (Jesus and His disciples) were <u>on their way up to</u> <u>Jerusalem</u>, with <u>Jesus leading the way</u>, and <u>the disciples were</u> <u>astonished</u>...

<u>John 10:14-18</u>

14 "I am the good shepherd... 15 ... <u>I lay down my life for the</u> <u>sheep. 16... 17 The reason my Father loves me is that I lay</u> <u>down my life</u> — only to take it up again. 18 <u>No one takes it</u> <u>from me</u>, but <u>I lay it down of my own accord</u>..."

Romans 5:8
