John 13:3-5,12-15

3 Jesus knew that the Father had put all things under his power, and that he had come from God and was returning to God; 4 so he got up from the meal, took off his outer clothing, and wrapped a towel around his waist. 5 After that, he poured water into a basin and began to wash his disciples' feet, drying them with the towel that was wrapped around him. 6-11 ... 12 When he had finished washing their feet, he put on his clothes and returned to his place. "Do you understand what I have done for you?" he asked them. 13 "You call me 'Teacher' and 'Lord,' and rightly so, for that is what I am. 14 Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. 15 I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you."

I. FEELS <u>CLOSEST</u> TO GOD WHEN THEY ARE <u>SERVING</u> OTHERS ON CHRIST'S BEHALF

To serve someone in the name of Christ is to love God Himself.

The Servants Heart is...

2. MODELED BY CHRIST HIMSELF

<u>True servanthood is fueled by:</u>

- KNOWING OUR <u>POWER</u> SOURCE John 13:3 Jesus knew that <u>the Father had put all things under</u> <u>his power</u>..
- KNOWING <u>WHOSE</u> WE ARE John 13:3 ... Jesus knew that <u>he had come from God</u>...
- KNOWING OUR PROMISED <u>FUTURE</u> John 13:3 ... Jesus knew that he <u>was returning to God</u>

John 13:5 ... So he began to wash his disciples' feet...

John 21 "Do you love me? Feed my sheep."

The Servants Heart...

3. <u>EMULATES</u> THE HEART OF CHRIST THROUGH <u>SERVANTHOOD</u>

Matt 20:26, 28

"26... Whoever wants to become great among you <u>must be your</u> servant, 27... 28 just as <u>the Son of Man did not come to be</u> served, <u>but to serve</u>, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

John 13:12, 14-15

12 When he had finished washing their feet, he put on his clothes and returned to his place. "Do you understand what I <u>have done for you</u>?" he asked them. 13... 14 "Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, <u>you also should wash</u> <u>one another's feet</u>. 15 <u>I have set you an example</u> that you should <u>do as I have done for you</u>."
