# 2. MUST HAVE <u>MIND</u> FULLY CONVINCED BEFORE <u>HEART</u> CAN FOLLOW

Romans 12:2 "be transformed by the renewing of your mind."

## Mark 12:28-31

28 One of the teachers of the law [asked Jesus] ..., "Of all the commandments, which is the most important?" 29 "The most important one," answered Jesus, "is this: 'Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. 30 Love the Lord your God with all your <u>heart</u> and with all your <u>soul</u> and <u>with all your mind</u> and with all your <u>strength</u>.' 31 The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no commandment greater than these."

# 3. SPIRITUALLY MATURES THROUGH STUDY

<u>1 Corinthians 3:1-2</u>

1 Brothers, I could not address you as spiritual but as worldly-<u>mere infants in Christ</u>. 2 I gave you <u>milk</u>, <u>not solid food</u>, for you were <u>not yet ready</u> for it. Indeed, you are <u>still not ready</u>.

#### <u>Hebrews 5:11-6:1</u>

11 We have much to say about this, but it is hard to explain because you are <u>slow to learn</u>. 12 In fact, though <u>by this time you</u> <u>ought to be teachers</u>, you need someone to teach you the <u>elementary truths</u> of God's word all over again. <u>You need milk</u>, <u>not solid food</u>! 13 Anyone who <u>lives on milk</u>, being <u>still an</u> <u>infant</u>, is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness. 14 But <u>solid food is for the mature</u>, who <u>by constant use</u> have <u>trained themselves</u> to distinguish <u>good from evil</u>. 6:1 Therefore let us <u>leave the elementary teachings</u> about Christ and <u>go on to</u> <u>maturity</u>...

### <u>John 20:27-29</u>

27 Then [Jesus] said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe." 28 Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!" 29 Then Jesus told him, "Because you have seen me, you have believed; <u>blessed are those who have not seen and yet</u> <u>have believed</u>."
