The Enemy of Thankfulness

Luke 18:9-14

9 To some who were confident of their own righteousness and looked down on everybody else, Jesus told this parable: 10 "Two men went up to the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. 11 The Pharisee stood up and prayed about himself: 'God, I thank you that I am not like other men — robbers, evildoers, adulterers — or even like this tax collector. 12 I fast twice a week and give a tenth of all I get.' 13 "But the tax collector stood at a distance. He would not even look up to heaven, but beat his breast and said, 'God, have mercy on me, a sinner.' 14 "I tell you that this man, rather than the other, went home justified before God. For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."

1. THE ENEMY OF THANKFULNESS IS SELF-CENTEREDNESS

<u>Luke 18:9</u>

Luke 18:11-12

II <u>The Pharisee</u> stood up and <u>prayed about himself</u>: 'God, <u>I</u> <u>thank you that I am not like other men</u> — robbers, evildoers, adulterers — or even like this tax collector. 12 I fast twice a week and give a tenth of all I get.'

Luke 9:23

Then he said to them all: "If anyone would come after me, he must <u>deny himself</u> and take up his cross daily and <u>follow me</u>."

2. THANKFULNESS FLOWS FROM HUMILITY

Luke 18:13

"But the tax collector stood at a distance. <u>He would not even</u> <u>look up to heaven</u>, but beat his breast and said, 'God, <u>have mercy</u> on me, a sinner.'"

3. WE LEARN HUMILITY FROM CHRIST

John 13:14-15

14 "Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. 15 <u>I have set you an example</u> that you should do as I have done for you."

Philippians 2:3-7

3 Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but <u>in</u> <u>humility consider others better than yourselves</u>. 4 Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. 5 <u>Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus</u>: 6 Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, 7 but <u>made himself nothing</u>...

4. HUMILITY <u>RESULTS</u> IN GOD'S <u>BLESSING</u>

Luke 18:14

[The tax collector] "... went home <u>justified before God</u>. For <u>everyone who exalts himself will be humbled</u>, and he who <u>humbles himself will be exalted</u>."

James 4:6

God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.

Philippians 2:8-9

8 And being found in appearance as a man, <u>he humbled himself</u> and became obedient to death — even death on a cross! 9 <u>Therefore God exalted him</u> to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name...
