# 4. SUFFER BECAUSE IT WAS GOD'S WILL

### <u>Isaiah 53:6</u>

We all, like sheep, have gone astray, <u>each of us has turned to his</u> <u>own way</u>; and <u>the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all</u>.

## <u>Isaiah 53:10</u>

... it was the Lord's will to crush him and cause him to suffer...

## Matthew 26:39

Going a little farther, he fell with his face to the ground and prayed, "My Father, if it is possible, <u>may this cup be taken from</u> <u>me</u>. Yet <u>not as I will</u>, but <u>as you will</u>."

## <u>Romans 3:23, 25</u>

23 for <u>all have sinned</u> and fall short of the glory of God, 24... <u>25</u> <u>God presented [Christ Jesus] as a sacrifice of atonement,</u> through faith in his blood.
