# 1. YOU WON'T GET OUT OF THIS LIFE WITHOUT EXPERIENCING TRIALS

#### 2 Corinthians 11:23-28

23 ... I have ... been in <u>prison</u> ... , been <u>flogged</u> ... and been <u>exposed to death</u> again and again. 24 Five times I received from the Jews the <u>forty lashes minus one</u>. 25 Three times I was <u>beaten</u> <u>with rods</u>, once I was <u>stoned</u>, three times I was <u>shipwrecked</u>, I spent a night and a day <u>in the open sea</u>, 26 I have been <u>constantly on the move</u>. I have been in <u>danger from rivers</u>, in <u>danger from bandits</u>, in <u>danger from my own countrymen</u>, in <u>danger from Gentiles</u>; in <u>danger in the city</u>, in <u>danger in the country</u>, in <u>danger at sea</u>; and in <u>danger from false brothers</u>. 27 I have <u>labored and toiled</u> and have often gone <u>without sleep</u>; I have <u>known hunger and thirst</u> and have often gone without <u>food</u>; I have been <u>cold</u> and <u>naked</u>. 28 Besides everything else, I face daily the pressure of my concern for all the churches.
