<u>Luke 15:11-24</u>

II Jesus continued: "There was a man who had two sons. 12 The younger one said to his father, 'Father, give me my share of the estate.' Let's have a feast and celebrate. 24 For this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.' So they began to celebrate."

To go from Lost to Found, we must...

I. ACKNOWLEDGE WE ARE A <u>BROKEN</u> PEOPLE <u>Luke 15:14</u> "he began to be in need."

<u>1 Samuel 2:2</u> There is <u>no one holy</u> like the LORD.

<u>Romans 3:10</u> There is <u>no one righteous</u>, not even one.

<u>Romans 3:23</u> <u>All have sinned</u> and <u>fall short</u> of the glory of God.

To go from Lost to Found, we must...

2. DEMONSTRATE <u>REMORSE</u>

<u>Luke 15:17</u> "he <u>came to his senses</u>"

Acts 2:38

Peter replied, "<u>Repent and be baptized</u>, <u>every one of you</u>, in the name of Jesus Christ <u>for the forgiveness of your sins</u>."

<u>Psalms 51:17</u>

The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; <u>a broken and contrite</u> <u>heart</u>...

To go from Lost to Found, we must...

3. <u>RETURN</u> TO OUR HEAVENLY FATHER <u>Luke 15:18</u> "I will set out and <u>go back to my father</u>"

To go from Lost to Found, we must...

4. ALLOW OURSELVES TO BE <u>EMBRACED</u> AND <u>RESTORED</u> BY OUR HEAVENLY FATHER <u>Luke 15:20, 22-24</u>

20... "... while he was still a long way off, <u>his father saw him and</u> was filled with compassion for him; <u>he ran to his son</u>, <u>threw his</u> <u>arms around him and kissed him</u>. 22 "... the father said to his servants, 'Quick! <u>Bring the best robe and put it on him</u>. <u>Put a</u> <u>ring on his finger and sandals on his feet</u>. 23 <u>Bring the fattened</u> <u>calf and kill it</u>. <u>Let's have a feast and celebrate</u>. 24 <u>For this son of</u> <u>mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found</u>.' So <u>they began to celebrate</u>."
