"8 This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples. 9 As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love. 10 If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have obeyed my Father's commands and remain in his love. 11 I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. 12 My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. 13 Greater love has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends. 14 You are my friends if you do what I command."

2. IS <u>DEMONSTRATED</u> BY JESUS

Romans 5:8

But <u>God demonstrates his own love for us</u> in this: <u>While we</u> were still sinners, Christ died for us.

1 John 3:16

This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us...

1 John 4:9-10, 19

9 This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. 10 This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.

19 We love because he first loved us.

"For God so <u>loved</u> the world that he <u>gave</u> his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."

Romans 8:35-39
