16 <u>All Scripture is God-breathed</u> and is useful for <u>teaching</u>, <u>rebuking</u>, <u>correcting</u> and <u>training in righteousness</u>, 17 so that the man of God may be <u>thoroughly equipped</u> for every good work.

False doctrines emerge when...

### I. SCRIPTURE IS INTERPRETED <u>ERRONEOUSLY</u>

That's why it's best to:

- Read (and study) Scripture for <u>yourself</u>
- Engage the <u>Holy Spirit</u> as you read and interpret Scripture
- Assess for <u>harmony</u> with other Scripture

False doctrines emerge when...

### 2. HUMAN IDEAS ARE <u>ADDED</u> TO SCRIPTURE

<u>2 Peter 2:1-3</u>

I ... <u>there will be false teachers among you</u>. They will <u>secretly</u> <u>introduce destructive heresies</u>, <u>even denying the sovereign Lord</u> <u>who bought them</u>-bringing swift destruction on themselves. 2 Many will follow their shameful ways and will bring the way of truth into disrepute. 3 In their greed <u>these teachers will exploit</u> <u>you with stories they have made up</u>. Their condemnation has long been hanging over them, and their destruction has not been sleeping.

False doctrines emerge when...

3. SCRIPTURE IS <u>SOFTENED</u> BY DISTORTING THE MEANING IN AN EFFORT NOT TO <u>OFFEND</u> (today we call that <u>Political Correctness</u>) <u>2 Timothy 4:3-4</u> 2 For the time will come when men will not put up with soun

3 For the time will come when men will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather

around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear. 4 They will <u>turn their ears away from</u> the truth and <u>turn aside to myths</u>.

# WHY SHOULD WE BELIEVE IN THE AUTHENTICITY OF GOD'S WORD?

- 1. <u>Jesus</u> himself constantly <u>referenced the OT writings</u>. "It is written..."
- The gospels are rooted in <u>multiple eyewitness testimony</u>.
  <u>2 Peter 1:16</u>
  <u>We did not follow cleverly invented stories</u> when we told you about the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but <u>we</u> were eyewitnesses of his majesty.
- The gospels were <u>written too close to the actual events</u> to be untrue. (written approximately 50 years after actual events, in the lifetime of many witnesses)
- 4. The <u>NT contains embarrassing and hard to explain material</u> that the authors would have deleted if they weren't true.
- 5. Science, archaeology and <u>ancient historical writings tend to</u> <u>corroborate</u> the Bible.
  - <u>Pool of Bethesda</u> described in John 5 discovered in 1800's
  - <u>Dead Sea Scrolls</u> dating back to 100AD discovered in Qumran, 1947
  - <u>Ruins of Jericho</u> described in Joshua 6 discovered in 1950's
- 6. Most of the <u>NT authors were martyred for their beliefs</u>. Would they have died for a lie?
- 7. It <u>CHANGED MY LIFE</u> !!
