5:11 We have much to say about this, but it is hard to explain because you are slow to learn. 12 In fact, though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God's word all over again. 3. OUR MATURITY BRINGS GOD GLORY

1 Peter 2:1-2, 9

1 Therefore, <u>rid yourselves</u> of all <u>malice</u> and all <u>deceit</u>, <u>hypocrisy</u>, <u>envy</u>, and <u>slander</u> of every kind. 2 ... <u>grow up in your salvation</u>, 3-8... 9 ... you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that <u>you may declare the praises of him</u> who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

Luke 8:14-15
