John 21:14-18

14 This was now the third time Jesus appeared to his disciples after he was raised from the dead. 15 When they had finished eating, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon son of John, do you truly love me more than these?" "Yes, Lord," he said, "you know that I love you." Jesus said, "Feed my lambs." 16 Again Jesus said, "Simon son of John, do you truly love me?" He answered, "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you." Jesus said, "Take care of my sheep." 17 The third time he said to him, "Simon son of John, do you love me?" Peter was hurt because Jesus asked him the third time, "Do you love me?" He said, "Lord, you know all things; you know that I love you." Jesus said, "Feed my sheep."

1. <u>JESUS</u> LOVES EXTRAVAGANTLY

John 3:14-16

"14 Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, 15 that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life. 16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, (so) that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."

John 8:28

So Jesus said, "When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am [the one I claim to be]..."

John 12:32-33

32 But I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to myself." 33 He said this to show the kind of death he was going to die.

2. YOU CAN'T <u>LOVE</u> EXTRAVAGANTLY UNTIL YOU REALIZE THAT YOU ARE <u>LOVED</u> EXTRAVAGANTLY

3. THE EXTRAVAGANT LOVE OF JESUS COMPELS US TO LOVE PEOPLE

John 13:34-35

34 "A new command I give you: <u>Love one another</u>. <u>As I have loved you</u>, so you must love one another. <u>35 By this all men will know that you are my disciples</u>, if you love one another."

John 15:12-13

"12 My command is this: <u>Love each other as I have loved you</u>. 13 <u>Greater love</u> has no one than this, that he <u>lay down his life for</u> his friends."

1 John 4:7-11

7 Dear friends, <u>let us love one another</u>, for <u>love comes from God</u>. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. 8 Whoever does not love does not know God, because <u>God is love</u>. 9 This is how <u>God showed his love</u> among us: <u>He sent his one and only Son</u> into the world <u>that we might live through him</u>. 10 This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and <u>sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins</u>. 11 Dear friends, <u>since God so loved us</u>, <u>we also ought to love one another</u>.
