### Matthew 5:1-12

1 Now when he saw the crowds, he went up on a mountainside and sat down. His disciples came to him, 2 and he began to teach them, saying: 3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 4 Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted. 5 Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth. 6 Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled. 7 Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy. 8 Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God. 9 Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called sons of God. 10 Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 11 Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. 12 Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you."

### I. JESUS DESIRES <u>BLESSING</u> AND <u>COMFORT</u> FOR YOU

<u>Matt 5:4</u> <u>Blessed</u> are those who <u>mourn</u>, for <u>they will be comforted</u>.

## 2. THE <u>BROKENNESS</u> OF THIS WORLD (AND EVEN OUR OWN <u>UNREPENTANT</u> SIN) <u>ROBS</u> US OF GOD'S BLESSING

<u>2 Samuel 12:1-7</u> (King David confronted by Nathan with his sin) 7 Then Nathan said to David, "<u>You are the man</u>!"

### Luke 13:34

"O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, you who kill the prophets and stone those sent to you, how often <u>I have longed to gather your</u> <u>children</u> together, <u>as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings</u>, but you were not willing!"

### <u>Luke 19:41-42</u>

41 As [Jesus] approached Jerusalem and saw the city, <u>he wept</u> over it 42 and said, "<u>If you, even you, had only known on this</u> <u>day what would bring you peace</u> — but now it is hidden from your eyes."

# 3. GOD <u>MOURNS</u> WITH US, <u>COMFORTS</u> US AND RESTORES OUR <u>PEACE</u>

<u>2 Corinthians 7:10</u> <u>Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation</u> and <u>leaves no regret</u>, but <u>worldly sorrow brings death</u>.

### <u>Psalms 51:10-12</u> (David's prayer of repentance)

10 Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. 11 Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me. 12 <u>Restore to me the joy of your salvation</u> and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.

### <u>Psalms 34:18</u>

The Lord is <u>close to the brokenhearted</u> and <u>saves those who are</u> <u>crushed in spirit</u>.

### Matthew 11:28

"<u>Come to me</u>, all you who are <u>weary and burdened</u>, and <u>I will</u> give you rest."

### <u>John 14:27</u>

"<u>Peace I leave with you</u>; <u>my peace I give you</u>. I do not give to you as the world gives. <u>Do not let your hearts be troubled</u> and do not be afraid."

### <u>2 Corinthians 1:3-4</u>

3 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and <u>the God of all comfort</u>, 4 who <u>comforts us in all our troubles</u>, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves have received from God.
