Acts 1:4-8

4 On one occasion, while [Jesus] was eating with them, he gave them this command: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. 5 For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit." 6 So when they met together, they asked him, "Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?" 7 He said to them: "It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. 8 "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

1. JESUS <u>PROMISED</u> TO SEND HIS HOLY SPIRIT AND HE <u>DELIVERED</u> ON HIS PROMISE (HE ALWAYS DOES)

Acts 2:1-4

I When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. 2 Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. 3 They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. 4 <u>All of them were</u> <u>filled with the Holy Spirit</u> and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

2. THE HOLY SPIRIT LIVES <u>IN</u> THE BELIEVER

3. BELIEVERS HAVE <u>POWER</u> THROUGH THE HOLY SPIRIT

<u>2 Timothy 1:7</u>

For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but <u>a spirit of</u> <u>power</u>, of love and of self-discipline.

<u>Acts 1:8</u>

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you..."

Galatians 5:16-17

16 So I say, <u>live by the Spirit</u>, and <u>you will not gratify the</u> <u>desires of the sinful nature</u>. 17 For the <u>sinful nature desires what</u> <u>is contrary to the Spirit</u>, and <u>the Spirit what is contrary to the</u> <u>sinful nature</u>. <u>They are in conflict with each other</u>, so that <u>you</u> <u>do not do what you want</u>.
