• A CHRISTIAN IS A <u>NEW CREATION</u>

<u>2 Corinthians 5:17</u>

<u>If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation;</u> the old has gone, the new has come!

• A CHRISTIAN HAS BEEN <u>REDEEMED</u>

<u>1 Peter 1:19</u>

[You were <u>redeemed</u>] <u>with the precious blood of Christ</u>, a lamb without blemish or defect.

• A CHRISTIAN HAS BEEN JUSTIFIED

<u>Romans 5:1-2</u>

I Therefore, since <u>we have been justified through faith</u>, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, 2 through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand.

A CHRISTIAN HAS BEEN PROMISED <u>ETERNAL LIFE</u>

<u>John 3:14-15</u>

14 Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, so <u>the Son of</u> <u>Man must be lifted up</u>, 15 that <u>everyone who believes in him</u> <u>may have eternal life</u>.

I. YOUR <u>SALVATION</u> IS A GIFT OF GOD

<u>Romans 6:23</u>

For the wages of sin is death, but <u>the gift of God</u> is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

2. THE <u>HOLY SPIRIT</u> IS A GIFT OF GOD

Acts 2:38-39

38 Peter replied, "<u>Repent and be baptized</u>, every one of you, <u>in</u> <u>the name of Jesus Christ</u> for the forgiveness of your sins.
