I. CALLED TO REMEMBER OUR DELIVERANCE

Exodus 12:13-14

[The Lord said to Moses] 13 The blood will be a sign for you on the houses where you are; and when I see the blood, I will pass over you. No destructive plague will touch you when I strike Egypt. 14 "This is a day you are to commemorate for the generations to come you shall celebrate it as a festival to the Lord — a lasting ordinance.

2. CALLED TO REMEMBER CHRIST'S SACRIFICIAL DEATH

Luke 22:14-21

14 When the hour came, Jesus and his apostles reclined at the table. 15 And he said to them, "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer." 16... 17 After taking the cup, he gave thanks and said, "Take this and divide it among you. 18 For I tell you I will not drink again of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." 19 And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me." 20 In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you."

3. CALLED TO REMEMBER CHRIST'S VICTORY OVER DEATH

Luke 24:5-8

5... "Why do you look for the living among the dead? 6 He is not here; he has risen! Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee: 7 'The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, be crucified and on the third day be raised again." 8 Then they remembered his words.

<u>1 Peter 1:18-19</u>
