2 Corinthians 12:2-10

2 I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven. Whether it was in the body or out of the body I do not know – God knows. 3 And I know that this man – whether in the body or apart from the body I do not know, but God knows— 4 was caught up to paradise. He heard inexpressible things, things that man is not permitted to tell. 5 I will boast about a man like that, but I will not boast about myself, except about my weaknesses. 6 Even if I should choose to boast, I would not be a fool, because I would be speaking the truth. But I refrain, so no one will think more of me than is warranted by what I do or say. 7 To keep me from becoming conceited because of these surpassingly great revelations, there was given me a thorn in my flesh, a messenger of Satan, to torment me. 8 Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me. 9 But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. 10 That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

I. THORNS KEEP US <u>HUMBLE</u>

<u>2 Corinthians 12:7</u>

<u>To keep me from becoming conceited</u> because of these surpassingly great revelations, <u>there was given me a thorn in my</u> <u>flesh</u>...

2 Corinthians 12:10

... <u>for Christ's sake</u>, <u>I delight in weaknesses</u>, in <u>insults</u>, in <u>hardships</u>, in <u>persecutions</u>, in <u>difficulties</u>...

2. THORNS PROMPT <u>RELIANCE</u> UPON GOD AND PRODUCE <u>GROWTH</u>

<u>2 Corinthians 12:8</u>

Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me.

Proverbs 3:5-6

5 <u>Trust in the Lord with all your heart</u> and <u>lean not on your own</u> <u>understanding</u>; 6 in all your ways acknowledge him, and <u>he will</u> <u>make your paths straight</u>.

James 1:2-4

2 <u>Consider it pure joy</u>, my brothers, <u>whenever you face trials</u> of many kinds, 3 because you know that <u>the testing of your faith</u> <u>develops perseverance</u>. 4 Perseverance must finish its work <u>so</u> <u>that you may be mature and complete</u>, not lacking anything.

3. THORNS <u>DEMONSTRATE</u> GOD'S <u>POWER</u>

<u>2 Corinthians 12:9-10</u>

9 But he said to me, "<u>My grace is sufficient for you</u>, for <u>my</u> <u>power is made perfect in weakness</u>." Therefore <u>I will boast all</u> <u>the more gladly about my weaknesses</u>, <u>so that Christ's power</u> <u>may rest on me</u>. 10... <u>when I am weak</u>, then I am strong.
